

Colorectal Trial Map

The colorectal trial map has been developed to provide a pictorial representation of the National Cancer Research Institute (NCRI) Colorectal Clinical Studies Group's trial portfolio. The map's purpose is to give an overview of the trials available for patients and to allow researchers to quickly identify areas for new research and areas of overcrowding which may lead to difficulties in recruitment.

The studies have been mapped as either treatment or non-treatment based studies then according to the specific type of colorectal cancer and form of treatment to be received, i.e either experimental or standard.

The studies mapped are either open and recruiting (yellow) or funded and in set up (purple). Each study is hyperlinked to the National Cancer Research Network (NCRN) database where further information such as a study summary and inclusion/exclusion criteria can be found. The map will be updated on a monthly basis.
